2. All contestants must provide their own lamb cuts, heating equipment grill, utensils, and serving materials.
3. Entrants may use any cuts of lamb in their recipes. The recipe must include at least 1 lb. of lamb.  
Must be U.S. lamb.
4. Include your recipe on your entry form so they can be duplicated for the people watching.
5. Judging will start at 4:00 PM
6. All entrants will receive a Licking County Lamb Cook-Off gift.
7. Plaques will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place winners and Gift Certificates for \$20, \$15, \$10.
