- All game must be legally harvested or purchased
- Recipe must be typed on a sheet of paper with entry, along with name, address and phone #. The HFNRA has permission to use the recipes for publications or recognition.
- Any age contestant may enter, one recipe per person
- HFNRA is not responsible for cooking containers or serving tools or lost recipes
- Judging starts promptly at 3:00 PM.
- Judging will be based on taste and most unusual.
- All entries must be made available for tasting by the audience upon completion of the contest.

- Judging starts promptly at 1:30 PM.
- Judging will be based on taste and the most unusual.
- All entries must be made available for tasting by the audience upon completion of the contest.
