Rules

1. The contestant must be able to pedal the tractor without help.
2. Pedal tractors will be furnished for all participants.
3. All Contestants must wear shoes.
4. The pulling tractor must stay between the lines of the pulling lane at all times.
5. If the tractor leaves the pulling lane the distance will be measured from the starting line to the point where the tractor crossed the boundary.
6. In case of a tie there will be a pull off to determine the winner.
7. Both girls and boys age 14 and under are eligible.
8. The judge's decision will be final for all pulls.
9. All contestants must be present by the time of the pedal pull with a signed permission slip in hand. The required signature of parent or guardian releases all parties involved from any financial responsibility due to accident.
10. Registration will be 1/2 hour before pull time.
11. Child must be accompanied by an adult or guardian at time of registration.
12. Spectators must stay in the stands.
