1. Entries close Saturday, **July 8, 2006** at 5:00 P.M.
2. Entry must be made whether a single animal or a group. Entrance fee is \$5.00 per animal. Purchase of a pass is no longer required.
3. Check health regulations printed in this tabloid. Health papers must be presented before unloading.
4. All dairy classes are for registered or grade cattle.
5. All exhibits must be in place 8:00 P.M. Sat, **Aug. 5th**.
6. Posted stalling assignments are final. There will be NO changes. **Bedding must be straw or pine shavings.**
7. Wash rack are shut down 6PM to 9PM.
8. No floor fans are allowed.
9. There is to be NO tack stored in the stall space. We reserve the right to remove any tack from stalls not being used to stall animals.
10. Each breed must have a minimum of 5 animals & 3 families exhibiting or the following year the class will be re-evaluated by the fair board for inclusion.
11. A rosette will be given for the Grand Champion, Reserve Champion and Junior Champion in each breed.
12. All Jr. Fair Cows will be shown with the Open Class Cows on Thursday. There will be no stalls available for cows. This is a one day show.

4. Summer Yearling Heifer (born June 1, **2005** thru August 31, **2005**)
5. Jr. Yearling Heifer (born March 1, **2005** thru May 31, **2005**)
6. Intermediate Yrlg Heifer (born December 1, **2004** thru February 28, **2005**)
7. Sr. Yearling Heifer (born September 1, **2004** thru November 30, **2004**)
8. Two Year Old Cow (born September 1, **2003** thru August 31, **2004**)
9. Three Year Old Cow (born September 1, **2002** thru August 31, **2003**)
10. Cow, 4 years or over (born before September 1, **2002**)
11. Dry cow that has produced at least one lactation
12. Jr. Get of Sire (3 animals under 2 years old)
13. Sr. Get of Sire (3 animals any age & at least one must have freshened)
14. Best 3 Female Animals (owned and bred by exhibitor)
15. Produce of Dam (2 animals any age, produce of one cow)
