Open Class Dairy Goat Show Friday, August 8th, 3:30 PM Jay N. Baird Memorial Arena

1. Enter day of show. No pre-entry necessary.
2. Entry fee is \$2.00 per animal.
3. One day, in and out show. Stalls available adjacent to arena, or show from truck or trailer. **There is a \$5.00 per person gate admission on your arrival.**
4. Double sanctioned by American Dairy Goat Association for Alpine, Lamancha, Nubian, Saanen, All Other Purebreds, and Recorded Grade. The Jr. & Sr. Shows are separately sanctioned. ADGA rules shall govern.
5. Unsanctioned classes for Utility (animals without registration papers), to precede the sanctioned ADGA show.
6. Ribbons will be awarded for first through fifth place and rosettes for Champion and Reserve Champion in each breed.
7. Original registration papers are required for animals six months of age or older. Stamped duplicates may be used for kids under 6 months of age. Papers must be shown to the show secretary between 12:00 and 2:00 PM. the day of the show for sanctioned classes.
8. All tattoos must be legible and correspond with the registration certificate.
9. Animals in the open show may arrive after 6:00 AM, August 8 and must be in place by 2:00 PM
10. Base date shall be the date of the show.
11. Tack is NOT to be stored in the stalls. The Fair Board reserves the right to remove any tack from stalls not being utilized strictly to stall animals.
12. Check health regulations printed in this tabloid.
13. All bedding MUST be removed from the pens/stalls before leaving or your premium will be held by the fair board. Bedding must be straw or pine shavings only.
14. Each breed must have a minimum of 5 animals and 3 families exhibiting or the following year the class will be re-evaluated for inclusion.
15. Only female animals can be exhibited.
16. Any Doe that has freshened shall compete only in the milking classes even though dry at the time of showing.

Order of Classes

Senior Does show will be followed by Junior Does Show.

1. Jr. Kid (born April 1st or after of current year)
2. Sr. Kid (born Jan 1st to March 31st of current year)
3. Dry Yearling (under 2 yrs of age, born prior to Jan. 1 of current year.)

- Goat/kid must be owned by the participant or belong to some member of the family.
- Only does, kids, or wethers may be used, no bucks.
- All Animals must be haltered, or collared with a lead rope.
- Sign up sheet day of show at the Goat/Sheep Arena 1 hour before the start of the show.

Hartford Fair Premium

All goat premiums will be mailed to the exhibitor 30 days following the show.

USDA Identification Program

All intact breeding animals entered in the Hartford Fair for the purpose of participating in the goat breeding class shows must follow guidelines as listed below:

- All intact breeding animals must be identified with official USDA approved identification, (USDA approved tags, USDA approved tattoos , or identification in the Scrapie Flock Certification Program).
 - All registered animals with accompanying registration tattoos would be acceptable once flock is registered with USDA (registration tags are not acceptable);
 - If the breeding animal was purchased outside of Ohio, the animal must have official USDA identification as well as a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) signed by both the veterinarian and the exhibitor within 30 days of the opening of the Hartford Fair. (CVI must attest to the following: "the goats in this shipment are not known to be under any movement restrictions because of scrapie.")
