

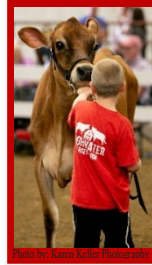

## DAIRY JUDGING CONTEST

**Monday – 12 Noon – Grubb Arena**

The contest will begin promptly at noon with instructions and any resource materials being provided at that time. Five classes of cows/heifers will be judged. Awards will be given on an individual basis only in two divisions – no teams. Junior division will consist of youth ages 9-13 (as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of current year) and senior division will be for those youth ages 14-19 (as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of current year). Awards will be presented to

the top five individuals in both divisions immediately following the conclusion of the contest. **Licking County Farm Bureau** will present a T-shirt to each participant in Dairy & General Livestock Judging Contest.
