POULTRY RULES

- Exhibits will be displayed in the Poultry/Rabbit building east of track.
- Poultry projects do not have to stay on the grounds but may come the day of the show.
- Poultry are to check in and be examined by the person in charge before being assigned a pen.
- Pens/cages are available in the barn for exhibits on a first come first serve basis. Locks are required on all pens, no locks will be allowed on pens prior to being stalled. Birds must be present to be assigned a pen and lock shall be placed at that time. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FEEDING, WATERING AND PEN CLEANING AS NEEDED! (See JR. FAIR RULES & INFORMATION #20 in this book)
- All exhibitors must be present when projects are being judged or judging will not be done and premiums will be withheld.
- NO ADULTS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW RING EXCEPT SHOW OFFICIALS. VIOLATORS MAY BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION!!
- Entry limitations of 2 per lot and 6 per division.
- Poultry must have a negative test for pullorum/fowl typhoid disease, within 90 days preceding the opening date of the exhibition and be accompanied by documentary evidence that they meet the requirement of this rule.

POULTRY CLASS DEFINITIONS

Market Poultry - Poultry raised for meat purposes only (Commercial)
Broiler - Chicken-male or female hatched after May 1st.
Duck & Turkey – Male or female hatched between March 1st and May 15th
Egg Type Poultry – Any species or breed of poultry commonly used in commercial egg production, excluding meat production and bantam breed or varieties.
Cock – Male chicken one year of age and older
Hen – Female chicken one year of age and older
Cockerel – Male chicken up to one year of age
Pullet – Female chicken up to one year of age
Fancy Poultry (Chickens) – Any breed Described in the APA Standard of Perfection
Fancy Duck – Any breed Described in the APA Standard of Perfection or the ABA Standard of Perfection

Age Description:

Old Drake – Male duck one year of age or older
Young Drake – Male duck up to one year of age
Old Duck – Female Duck one year of age or older
Young Duck – Female duck up to one year of age.

MANDATORY LEG OR WING BAND ON ALL POULTRY

Layers and Fancy Poultry & Turkeys to be leg banded the 1st Saturday in May at the fairgrounds poultry/rabbit barn 10:00 am - 2:00 pm

Meat Poultry to be wing banded the 2nd Saturday in July at the fairgrounds poultry/rabbit barn 10:00 am - 2:00 p.m.

In case of death of an animal, replacement may be made with approval of advisor and Sr. Fair Board member in charge. Replacement must be made with the same breed, sex and age of the animal lost. There is a \$1.00 charge per entry.

ROOSTER CROWING CONTEST

Rules and Guidelines

1. This is a fun event and there is no entry fee. Any Jr. Fair Exhibitor is eligible. Previous winners may compete.
2. The competition will be held two days, Thursday and Friday of the Fair. Registration will begin at 8:00 am Thursday. The competition will begin at 8:00 am Thursday and 8:00 am Friday. The rooster with the most “crows” in the two (2) day time periods will be judged as the winner.
3. Youth must be present both days of the contest. If you are not able to be present, you may ask another Jr. Fair Exhibitor to represent you at the contest. **Animal House 4-H Club** will sponsor a trophy for the winner. Trophy will be presented at the small animal auction on Saturday



POULTRY POSTER CONTEST



The purpose of this contest is to demonstrate the Jr. Fair exhibitor’s project knowledge, to stimulate interest, and to demonstrate to others the diversity of the Poultry Junior Fair Projects.

CONTEST RULES

1. Each poster must be made by the 4-H or FFA member.
2. Posters must be made using 22”x 28” poster board, displayed horizontally with stiff backing. (It is suggested your poster be covered with clear plastic)
3. Each poster must be clearly labeled in the lower right-hand corner, in a space no larger than 3”x 5” with the exhibitor’s name, club or chapter, and age as of January 1st of the current year.
4. Poster will be judged on:
 - Educational Content 50 points
 - Neatness/Appearance 30 points
 - Originality 20 points
5. Posters will be displayed at the Poultry/Rabbit Barn during the fair. Poultry Posters must be in place by Tuesday - 10:00 AM.
6. Junior Division 9 to 13 years of age
7. Senior Division 14 to 19 years
8. No entry fee - this is a free class - no premiums will be given. Rosettes will be awarded for places 1 thru 5 - **Rabbit/Poultry Committee**
