### OPEN CLASS DAIRY GOAT SHOW

#### FRIDAY, AUGUST 13<sup>th</sup> @ 3:30 PM @ BAIRD MEMORIAL ARENA

Enter day of show. No pre-entry necessary.

- Entry fee is \$5.00 per animal.
- One day, in and out show. Stalls available adjacent to arena, or show from truck or trailer. There is a \$8.00 per person gate admission on your arrival.
- Double sanctioned by American Dairy Goat Association for Alpine, Nigerian Dwarf, Nubian, Toggenberg, All Other Purebreds and Recorded Grade.
- The Jr. & Sr. Shows are separately sanctioned. ADGA rules shall govern.
- Ribbons will be awarded for 1st - 5th place. Rosettes for Champion & Reserve Champion each breed. Premium checks will be mailed.
- Original registration papers are required for animals six months of age or older. Stamped duplicates may be used for kids under 6 months of age. Papers must be shown to the show secretary between 12:00 and 3:00 PM. the day of the show for sanctioned classes.
- All tattoos must be legible and correspond with the registration certificate.
- Animals in the open show may arrive after 6 am Friday, Aug. 13<sup>th</sup> and must be in place by 2 pm.
- Base date shall be the date of the show.
- Tack is NOT to be stored in the stalls. The Fair Board reserves the right to remove any tack from stalls not being utilized strictly to stall animals.
- Check health regulations printed in this tabloid.
- All bedding must be removed from the pens/stalls before leaving or your premium will be held by the fair board. Bedding must be straw or pine shavings only.
- Each breed must have a minimum of 5 animals and 3 families exhibiting or the following year the class will be re-evaluated for inclusion.
- Only female animals can be exhibited.
- Any Doe that has freshened shall compete only in the milking classes even though dry at the time of showing.
- The show order is as follows and will not be subject to change.

7. Scrapie ID needed for all exhibited animals.
8. Market Does and Wethers must be Slick Shorn above the Hock & Knee.
9. Must be entered in Open Market Goat Show to participate in Open Market Goat Showmanship.
