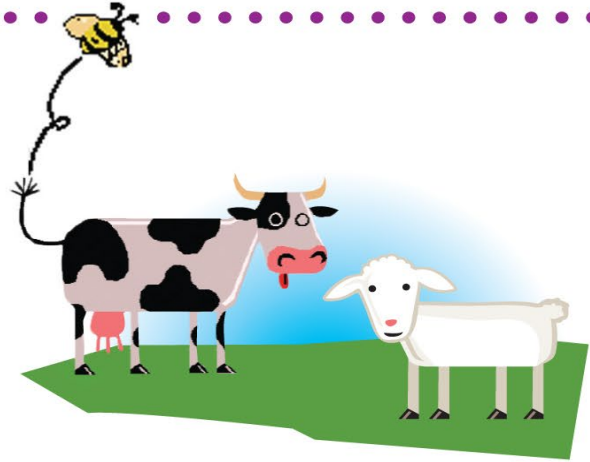

3. Entrants may use any cuts of lamb in their recipes. The recipe must include at least 1 lb. of lamb. Must be U.S. lamb.
4. Include your recipe on your entry form so they can be duplicated for the people watching.
5. Judging will start at 6 pm.
6. All entrants will receive a Licking County Lamb Cook-Off gift.
7. Plaques will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place winners and Gift Certificates for \$20, \$15, \$10.
