Hog must be in exhibitor's possession 90 days before fair. There is a maximum entry of two (2) hogs total.

Market hogs will be weighed one time only. Classes will be divided according to number and weight, and according to sex. The Classes will then be separated into 4 Divisions (Light, Medium, Light Heavy & Heavy).

The Gr. Champ (Gilt & Barrow) of each division will return for the Final Drive, in which a Supreme Champion will be chosen from.

ATTENTION ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO READ THE "LIVESTOCK RULES & REGULATIONS".

SWINE RULES

1. Powdering, oiling, or any dressing of hogs other than washing and clean water will not be allowed at the Hartford Fair. Exhibitors will be disqualified from showing if they do not follow this rule. Slick clipping or body shaving must have a minimum of one half (1/2) inch hair on body. ABSOLUTELY NO clipping of hogs will be allowed on show grounds. Whole body clipping of market hogs is discouraged. The Executive Committee and Swine committee will interpret all rules not covered in the general rules.
2. Following the new state guidelines, there will be no health papers required for market hogs, but you will be required to complete a DUNF form for each hog (online) by noon on Sunday, after tag is placed in its ear.
3. Bedding must be straw or pine shavings only. No floor fans allowed.
4. Weights – Hogs must weigh 200lbs. (Hogs under 200lbs. will not be sold) or heavier to compete at the Hartford Fair. Hogs weighing less than 200lbs. will not be allowed to show or sell. Only the hogs weighing between 220lbs. - 290lbs. will be allowed to show in the champion or reserve champion drive. There will be 30 classes. Classes will be set up equally after the hogs have been weighed.
5. All trailers left on fairground during fair week must be parked in designated area.
6. All hogs must be identified by either ear notches or ear tag along with breed and color markings and 2 photos of each hog (one of the head and one of the sides). This form must be submitted online to the Hartford Fair on or before May 15 each year. You can identify up to 4 hogs but only 2 hogs may be brought to the fair per exhibitor.
7. If ID is not submitted by May 15 deadline, the animal will not qualify for Champion.
8. Champion & Reserve Champion will be tattooed with fair ID# immediately as declared winners.
9. Barn closes at 11:00 PM every night.

1. CLEANLINESS AND NEATNESS OF GENERAL EXHIBIT AREA.
2. CARE OF ANIMALS (CLEAN AND WELL GROOMED).
3. COOPERATION WITH OTHERS
4. EFFORT PUT FORTH BY INDIVIDUAL.

OPEN SWINE CONTESTS

PEE WEE SHOWMANSHIP

A SHOW FOR AGES 4 - 8 YEARS OLD (AGE AS OF THE DATE OF THE PEE WEE SHOW) WILL BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY AT 10 AM. THE SHOW IS STRICTLY AN EDUCATIONAL EVENT. A PARTICIPATION RIBBON WILL BE GIVEN TO EACH PARTICIPANT. SIGN UP FOR THIS EVENT WILL BE AT THE HOG ARENA.

OLD TIMERS SHOWMANSHIP

A SHOW FOR AGES 20 AND OVER WILL BE HELD ON MONDAY IMMEDIATELY FOLLOWING THE JR. FAIR SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES . REQUIRED TO BE A 4-H ADVISOR, 4-H PARENT, FFA ADVISOR OR FORMER 4-H MEMBER IN THE HARTFORD FAIR DISTRICT. JUDGING WILL BE STRICTLY ON THE SHOWMANSHIP OF THE INDIVIDUAL AND NOT THE ANIMAL. IT IS NOT REQUIRED THAT ANYONE MUST OWN THE ANIMAL, WHICH THEY EXHIBIT IN THIS CLASS. THE CLASS MAY BE DIVIDED IF NECESSARY AND RIBBONS AND TROPHIES WILL BE AWARDED.
