POULTRY DEFINITIONS

- MARKET POULTRY - POULTRY RAISED FOR MEAT PURPOSE ONLY.
- BROILER - CHICKEN- MALE OR FEMALE, HATCHED AFTER MAY 1st.
- DUCK & TURKEY - MALE OR FEMALE, HATCHED BETWEEN MARCH 1st - MAY 15th.
- EGG TYPE POULTRY - POULTRY COMMONLY USED IN COMMERCIAL EGG PRODUCTION, EXCLUDES MEAT PRODUCTION AND BANTAM VARIETY.
- COCK - MALE CHICKEN 1 YEAR OF AGE OR OLDER.
- HEN - FEMALE CHICKEN 1 YEAR OF AGE OR OLDER.
- COCKEREL - MALE CHICKEN UP TO ONE YEAR OF AGE.
- PULLET - FEMALE CHICKEN UP TO ONE YEAR OF AGE.
- FANCY POULTRY - ANY CHICKEN BREED DESCRIBED IN THE APA STANDARD OF PERFECTION.
- FANCY DUCK - ANY DUCK BREED DESCRIBED IN THE APA OR ABA STANDARD OF PERFECTION.

AGE DESCRIPTION

- OLD DRAKE - MALE DUCK ONE YEAR OF AGE OR OLDER
- YOUNG DRAKE - MALE DUCK UP TO ONE YEAR OF AGE
- OLD DUCK - FEMALE DUCK ONE YEAR OF AGE OR OLDER
- YOUNG DUCK - FEMALE DUCK UP TO ONE YEAR OF AGE

ATTENTION ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO READ THE "LIVESTOCK RULES & REGULATIONS".

POULTRY RULES

1. ENTRY LIMITATIONS OF 2 PER LOT AND 6 PER DIVISION
2. EXHIBITS WILL BE DISPLAYED IN THE SMALL ANIMAL BARN EAST OF THE TRACK
3. POULTRY PROJECTS DO NOT HAVE TO STAY ON THE GROUNDS, THEY MAY COME DAY OF THE SHOW
4. POULTRY ARE TO CHECK IN AND BE EXAMINED BY THE PERSON IN CHARGE, PRIOR TO STALLING
5. PENS ARE AVAILABLE ON A FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS. LOCKS ARE REQUIRED ON ALL PENS, NO LOCKS WILL BE ALLOWED ON PENS PRIOR TO BEING STALLED. BIRDS MUST BE PRESENT TO BE ASSIGNED A PEN.
6. ALL EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FEEDING, WATER AND PEN CLEANING!
(SEE JR. FAIR RULES & INFORMATION #20)
7. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST BE PRESENT WHEN PROJECTS ARE BEING JUDGED OR JUDGING WILL NOT BE DONE AND PREMIUMS WILL BE WITHHELD
8. NO ADULTS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW RING, EXCEPT SHOW OFFICIALS, VIOLATORS MAY BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION.
9. POULTRY MUST HAVE NEGATIVE TEST FOR PULLORUM/FOWL TYPHOID DISEASE, WITHIN 90 DAYS PRECEDING THE OPENING DATE OF EXHIBITION AND BE ACCOMPANIED BY DOCUMENTARY EVIDENCE THAT THEY MEET REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE.
10. IN CASE OF DEATH OF AN ANIMAL, REPLACEMENT MAY BE MADE WITH APPROVAL OF ADVISOR AND SR. FAIR BOARD MEMBER IN CHARGE. REPLACEMENT MUST BE MADE WITH THE SAME BREED, SEX AND AGE OF THE ANIMAL LOST. THERE IS A \$1.00 CHARGE PER ENTRY.
11. BARN CLOSES AT 11:00PM EVERY NIGHT.

ROOSTER CROWING CONTEST

Contest Rules

1. This is a fun event and there is no entry fee. Any Jr. Fair Exhibitor is eligible. Previous winners may compete.
2. The competition will be held Friday of the Fair. Registration will begin at 8:00 am. The competition will begin at 8:00 am Friday. The rooster with the most “crows” in the daytime period will be judged as the winner.
3. Youth must be present at the contest. If you are not able to be present, you may ask another Jr. Fair Exhibitor to represent you at the contest. A trophy will be presented at the small animal auction on Saturday.

POULTRY POSTER CONTEST

The purpose of this contest is to demonstrate the Jr. Fair Exhibitor’s project knowledge, to stimulate interest and to demonstrate the diversity of the Poultry Junior Fair Projects.

Contest Rules

1. Each poster must be made by the 4-H or FFA member.
2. Posters must be made using 22”x 28” poster board, displayed horizontally with stiff backing. (It is suggested your poster be covered with clear plastic). Posters will be displayed at the Small Animal Barn during the Fair.
3. Each poster must be clearly labeled in the lower right- hand corner, in a space no larger than 3”x 5” with the exhibitor’s name, club or chapter, and age as of January 1st of the current year.
4. Poster will be judged on:

Educational Content	50 Points
Neatness/Appearance	30 Points
Originality	20 Points

5. Posters must be in place by Tuesday – 10:00 AM.
6. Junior Division 9 to 13 years of age
7. Senior Division 14 to 19 years
8. No entry fee - this is a free class - no premiums will be given.
