IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO READ THE "LIVESTOCK RULES & REGULATIONS".

GENERAL OPEN GOAT RULES

- 1. ALL GOATS EXHIBITED MUST HAVE OFFICIAL USDA SCRAPIES IDENTIFICATION TO SHOW.
- 2. HAUL-IN ANIMALS SHOULD PLAN TO SHOW FROM THEIR TRAILERS, AS PENS MAY NOT BE AVAILABLE.
- 3. IF STALLING, TACK IS NOT TO BE STORED IN THE STALLS. THE FAIR BOARD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY TACK FROM STALLS NOT BEING UTILIZED STRICTLY TO STALL ANIMALS.
- 4. BEDDING MUST BE EITHER STRAW OR PINE SHAVINGS AND STALLS MUST BE CLEANED BEFORE LEAVING THE GROUNDS OR EXHIBITOR WILL BE INELIGIBLE TO SHOW THE FOLLOWING YEAR.
- 5. NO USE OF BARN ELECTRIC FOR PERSONAL FANS, CROCKPOTS, AND OTHER APPLIANCES UNLESS DIRECTLY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE LIVESTOCK. BLOWERS MUST BE RUN ON GENERATORS.
- 6. NO USE OF MUZZLES.
- 7. ALL GOAT SHOWS, JUNIOR AND OPEN, WILL BE SUBJECT TO OHIO LIVESTOCK HEALTH EXHIBITION RULES & OHIO LIVESTOCK TAMPERING EXHIBITION RULES AS LISTED ON OUR WEBSITE. THE RULES INCLUDE BUT NOT LIMITED TO:

a. UNACCEPTABLE PRACTICES

- i. USING ICE, ICE PACKS, COLD PACKS, OR COLD COMPRESSES INTERNALLY OR EXTERNALLY UNLESS PRESCRIBED BY THE FAIR VETERINARIAN.
- ii. DRENCHING OF LIVESTOCK AT AN EXHIBITION IS PROHIBITED EXCEPT AS PRESCRIBED AND DONE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE FAIR VETERINARIAN.

b. PROHIBITED GROOMING PRACTICES

- i. USING ANY SUBSTANCE TO ENHANCE OR CHANGE THE COLOR OF THE LIVESTOCK, INCLUDING THE LIVESTOCK'S HIDE OR HOOVES. ADDING ANY SUBSTANCE INTERNALLY TO BUILD UP, CHANGE, OR ALTER THE SHAPE OR CONFORMATION OF THE LIVESTOCK. INCLUDING BY WAY OF EXAMPLE BUT NOT LIMITED TO ROPE, FALSE HAIR, GRAPHITE, HEMP, AND POWDERS. THIS INCLUDES POWDERS, POWDERED PAINTS, AND PAINT, PER STATE VETERINARIAN.
- 8. BARN CLOSES AT 11:00 PM EVERY NIGHT.

OPEN CLASS DAIRY GOAT RULES

PRE-REGISTER OR ENTER DAY OF SHOW

- OPEN TO ALL AGES OF EXHIBITOR, GATE ADMISSION PAID ON ARRIVAL.
- 2. ENTRY FEES ARE AS FOLLOWS
 - a. \$6 PER ANIMAL DAY OF SHOW (CASH ONLY)
- 3. PRE-REGISTRATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE ONLINE WITH DIRECTIONS FOR SUBMISSION.
- 4. JUNIOR AND COMBINED SENIOR/JUNIOR SHOWS ARE SEPARATELY SANCTIONED BY THE AMERICAN DAIRY GOAT ASSOCIATION FOR THE BREED CLASSES LISTED. TO FACILITATE A SMOOTH SHOW, THE ORDER OF THE SHOW IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE. ADGA RULES SHALL GOVERN.
- 5. JR DOES WILL BE SHOWN IN THE COMBINED SENIOR/JUNIOR SHOW ONLY IF THEY ARE NEEDED TO MAKE NUMBERS. ENTRY OF JUNIOR DOES INTO THE COMBINED SHOW WILL BE DETERMINED BY THE SHOW COMMITTEE.
- 6. ADGA ROSETTES WILL BE AWARDED TO THE CHAMPION & RESERVE CHAMPION OF EACH BREED. PREMIUMS WILL BE PAID AT THE SHOW ARENA ON THE DAY OF THE SHOW.
- 7. ORIGINAL REGISTRATION PAPERS ARE REQUIRED FOR ANIMALS SIX (6) MONTHS OF AGE OR OLDER. STAMPED DUPLICATES MAY BE USED FOR KIDS UNDER SIX (6) MONTHS OF AGE. PAPERS MUST BE SHOWN TO THE SHOW SECRETARY BETWEEN 12:00 AND 3:00 PM THE DAY OF THE SHOW FOR SANCTIONED CLASSES.
- 8. ALL TATTOOS MUST BE LEGIBLE AND CORRESPOND WITH THE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE. IF AN ANIMAL HAS A MICROCHIP. THE EXHIBITOR IS ASKED TO BRING A MICROCHIP READER WITH THEM.
- 9. ANIMALS IN THE OPEN SHOW MAY ARRIVE AFTER 6 AM AND MUST BE IN PLACE BY 2 PM ON DAY OF SHOW.
- 10. BASE DATE SHALL BE THE DATE OF THE SHOW.
- 11. CHECK THE HEALTH REGULATIONS POSTED IN THE LIVESTOCK HEALTH RULES/REGULATIONS ON THE HARTFORD FAIR WEBSITE.
- 12. EACH BREED MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF FIVE (5) ANIMALS AND THREE (3) FAMILIES EXHIBITING OR THE FOLLOWING YEAR THE CLASS WILL BE REEVALUATED FOR INCLUSION.
- 13. ONLY FEMALE ANIMALS CAN BE EXHIBITED.
- 14.ANY DOE THAT HAS FRESHENED SHALL COMPETE ONLY IN THE MILKING CLASSES EVEN THOUGH DRY AT THE TIME OF SHOWING.
- 15. DOES SHOWN IN LOT #10 MUST ALSO SHOW IN THEIR RESPECTIVE AGE CLASSES.
- 16.THE COMBINED SENIOR/JUNIOR DOE SHOW WILL BE HELD FIRST, FOLLOWED BY THE JUNIOR DOE SHOW.

OPEN CLASS PYGMY GOAT RULES

- 1. THE SHOW IS AN UNSANCTIONED FUN SHOW STARTING WITH SHOWMANSHIP FOLLOWED BY OPEN CLASSES.
- 2. OPEN TO ALL AGES OF EXHIBITOR, GATE ADMISSION PAID ON ARRIVAL.
- 3. SHOWMANSHIP CLASSES FOR PEEWEE (UNDER AGE 8), BEGINNER (8-12 YRS), TEEN (13-17 YRS), ADULT (18YRS+) & EXPERT. FREE TO ENTER WITH ANIMAL ENTERED IN PYGMY GOAT SHOW. SIGN UP DAY OF SHOW.
- 4. ENTRY FEES ARE AS FOLLOWS:
 - a. \$6 PER ANIMAL DAY OF SHOW (CASH ONLY)
- PRE-REGISTRATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE ONLINE WITH DIRECTIONS FOR SUBMISSION.
- 6. ANIMALS MAY ENTER THE GROUNDS AFTER 6:00 AM ON THURSDAY.
- 7. ROSETTES FOR PLACES 1ST-5TH. BANNERS FOR GRAND AND RESERVE.
- 8. ALL GOATS MUST HAVE OFFICAL USDA SCRAPIES IDENTIFICATION TO EXHIBIT (CHIPS LOCATED IN THE WITHERS ARE NOT CONSIDERED OFFICIAL USDA SCRAPIES ID)

OPEN MARKET GOAT RULES

- 1. SHOW IS OPEN TO ALL YOUTH (5 19) FROM ALL AREAS.
- 2. NO PRE-ENTRY. ENTER DAY OF SHOW.
- ENTRY FEE IS \$10 PER ANIMAL AND DOES NOT INCLUDE GATE ADMISSION.
- 4. DOES AND WETHERS MILK TEETH PRESENT- NO WEIGHT LIMIT NO PAPERS REQUIRED
- 5. WEIGH IN AT 10AM FOR HARTFORD FAIR JR MARKET GOAT PROJECTS
- 6. WEIGH IN AT 11AM FOR ALL NON-HOUSED GOATS. MUST ENTER THRU GATE D-2 AND BE ON THE FAIRGROUNDS BEFORE 11 AM DAY OF SHOW.
- 7. SCRAPIES ID NEEDED FOR ALL EXHIBITED ANIMALS.
- 8. MARKET DOES AND WETHERS MUST BE SLICK SHORN ABOVE THE HOCK & KNEE.
- 9. MUST BE ENTERED IN OPEN MARKET GOAT SHOW TO PARTICIPATE IN OPEN MARKET GOAT SHOWMANSHIP.

PEE WEE GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

- 1. CHILDREN 8 YEARS OF AGE OR YOUNGER CLASSES WILL BE DETERMINED DAY OF SHOW.
- 2. SHOW IS STRICTLY AN EDUCATIONAL EVENT. PARTICIPATION RIBBON WILL BE AWARDED TO ALL.
- 3. ONLY DOES, KIDS, OR WETHERS MAY BE USED, NO BUCKS.
- 4. ALL ANIMALS MUST BE HALTERED OR COLLARED WITH A LEAD ROPE. SIGN-UP SHEET DAY OF SHOW AT GRUBB ARENA, ONE (1) HOUR BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW.
- 5. SCRAPIES IDENTIFICATION IS NEEDED FOR ALL EXHIBITED ANIMALS.

OLD-TIMERS GOAT SHOWMANSHIP

- 1. **ADGA OPEN DAIRY GOAT:** MUST BE 21 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER. ONLY DOES, KIDS, OR WETHERS MAY BE SHOWN, NO BUCKS.
- 2. **MARKET GOAT:** MUST BE OUT OF 4-H AGE OR OLDER. ONLY DOES, KIDS, OR WETHERS MAY BE SHOWN, NO BUCKS.
