ALL PET GOAT PROJECTS SHOULD BE ENTERED IN DEPT. 118 UNDER SPECIAL INTEREST PROJECT. THEY WILL COMPLETE JUDGING AT THE COUNTY LEVEL. THESE PROJECTS WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR EXHIBIT ONLY THROUGH STILL PROJECT DISPLAY OPPORTUNITIES IN THE 4-H CENTER. THE PET GOAT WILL NOT BE BROUGHT TO THE FAIRGROUNDS OR SHOWN.

ATTENTION ALL LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS

IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO READ THE "LIVESTOCK RULES & REGULATIONS".

GOAT RULES

1. ONLY FEMALE & WETHER ANIMALS ARE ALLOWED. NO HORNED GOATS AND NO HORN SCURS OVER 3 INCHES LONG IN DAIRY CLASSES. NO KIDS UNDER 30 DAYS OLD ARE ALLOWED DUE TO STATE OF OHIO REGULATIONS. NO BUCKLINGS ALLOWED.
2. ALL GOATS EXHIBITED MUST HAVE OFFICIAL USDA SCRAPIE IDENTIFICATION, INCLUDING MARKET WETHERS TO SHOW OR SELL AT THE FAIR.
3. TENTS ARE PROHIBITED AROUND THE BARN EXCEPT FOR THE EXPRESS PURPOSE OF GROOMING OR FITTING ON SHOW DAYS AND MUST BE REMOVED FOLLOWING THE SHOW. THEY MAY BE SET-UP IN A PRE-DESIGNATED AREA OF THE TRAILER LOT TO THE EAST OF THE GOAT BARN.
4. THREE SIDES OF THE GOAT PENS MUST ALLOW AIRFLOW TO PASS THROUGH (MAY BE COVERED WITH LATTICE, CHICKEN WIRE, LIVESTOCK PANEL, ETC., NO PLYWOOD WITH DRILLED HOLES). BOARDS MUST NOT EXTEND ABOVE THE GATES. 18" OR SHORTER KICKBOARDS ARE ALLOWED ON ALL SIDES.
5. GATES IN GOAT PENS MUST STAY IN PENS. CENTER DIVIDERS MUST BE FASTENED TO BACK OF PEN IF TAKEN DOWN. CANNOT REMOVE 2 CONSECUTIVE CENTER DIVIDERS. HARTFORD FAIR BOARD RESERVES THE RIGHT TO PUT DIVIDERS BACK.
6. SOLID TARPS MAY NOT BE HUNG FROM THE BARN. SUNSHADES OR MESH TARPS ARE ALLOWED AT THE DISCRETION OF THE HARTFORD SENIOR FAIR BOARD.
7. NO USE OF BARN ELECTRIC FOR PERSONAL FANS, CROCKPOTS, AND OTHER APPLIANCES UNLESS DIRECTLY FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE LIVESTOCK. BLOWERS MUST BE RUN ON GENERATORS.
8. BEDDING MUST BE EITHER STRAW OR PINE SHAVINGS.
9. NO USE OF MUZZLES.
10. NO EXERCISING GOATS IN THE HORSE HAUL-IN PARKING LOT SOUTH OF THE GOAT BARN.
11. A GOAT MAY ONLY BE ENTERED IN ONE CLASS WITH THE EXCEPTION OF BEING ENTERED IN SHOWMANSHIP AS WELL.
12. SAME GOAT MUST BE SHOWN FOR ALL HEATS OF SHOWMANSHIP & SUPER SHOWMANSHIP.
13. GRAND & RESERVE CHAMPION MARKET GOAT MUST GO TO SLAUGHTER AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO DRUG TESTING.
14. MARKET GOATS MUST BE SLICK SHORN ABOVE THE HOCK AND KNEE LESS THAN 10 DAYS PRIOR TO THE FAIR.
15. DAIRY GOATS ENTERED IN CLASSES JA, JB, JC, OR JD, LOTS 4-7, MAY BE HAULED IN DAY OF SHOW AS LONG AS THEY ARE IN MILK.
16. REVIEW ALL OF THE OHIO LIVESTOCK HEALTH EXHIBITION RULES & OHIO LIVESTOCK TAMPERING EXHIBITION RULES AT THE FRONT OF THIS BOOK. VIOLATORS OF THESE RULES ARE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION. THE RULES INCLUDE BUT ARE NOT LIMITED TO:
 - a. DAIRY GOATS: AGE BASED ON GOATS AGE AS OF AUGUST 1ST OF CURRENT YEAR
 - b. DAIRY GOATS: ANY DOE THAT HAS EVER FRESHENED SHALL COMPETE ONLY IN THE MILKING CLASSES, EVEN THOUGH DRY AT THE TIME OF SHOWING.
17. **UNACCEPTABLE PRACTICES**
USING ICE, ICE PACKS, COLD PACKS, OR COLD COMPRESSES INTERNALLY OR EXTERNALLY UNLESS PRESCRIBED BY THE FAIR VETERINARIAN. DRENCHING OF LIVESTOCK AT AN EXHIBITION IS PROHIBITED EXCEPT AS PRESCRIBED AND DONE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE FAIR VETERINARIAN.
18. **PROHIBITED GROOMING PRACTICES:**
USING ANY SUBSTANCE TO ENHANCE OR CHANGE THE COLOR OF THE LIVESTOCK, INCLUDING THE LIVESTOCK'S HIDE OR HOOVES. ADDING ANY SUBSTANCE INTERNALLY TO BUILD UP, CHANGE, OR ALTER THE SHAPE OR CONFORMATION OF THE LIVESTOCK. INCLUDING BY WAY OF EXAMPLE BUT NOT LIMITED TO ROPE, FALSE HAIR, GRAPHITE, HEMP, AND POWDERS. THIS INCLUDES POWDERS, POWDERED PAINTS, AND PAINT, PER STATE VETERINARIAN.
19. BARN CLOSSES AT 11:00PM EVERY NIGHT.

MARKET GOAT BRED & OWNED RULES

1. BRED & OWNED MARKET GOAT CHAMPIONS WILL BE AWARDED WITHIN THE JUNIOR MARKET GOAT SHOW.
2. TOP 2 PLACING B&O ANIMALS IN EACH MARKET CLASS WILL COMPETE IN THE B&O CHAMPION DRIVE.
3. B&O ANIMALS MUST BE DESIGNATED AT TIME OF TAGGING AND VERIFIED BY USDA SCRAPIES PREMISE ID.
4. ANIMALS WITHOUT OFFICIAL SCRAPIES ID AT TIME OF TAGGING ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR B&O.
5. EXHIBITOR MUST BE ABLE TO PROVE SCRAPIES ID BELONGS TO THEMSELVES, PARENT, STEP-PARENT, OR GRANDPARENT UPON REQUEST.
6. EXHIBITOR, PARENT, STEP-PARENT, OR GRANDPARENT MUST HAVE OWNERSHIP OF THE DAM AT THE TIME OF BREEDING (MAY NOT PURCHASE A BRED DOE).

2023 MARKET GOAT TAGGING AND WEIGHING

ALL MARKET GOATS MUST BE TAGGED AT MAY TAGGING EVENT. EACH EXHIBITOR MAY TAG UP TO SIX (6) MARKET GOATS BUT NO MORE THAN TWO (2) MAY BE EXHIBITED AND ONLY ONE MAY SELL. THE GOATS BEING TAGGED MUST BE DESIGNATED TO A PARTICULAR EXHIBITOR. THIS WILL BE DONE THE THIRD SATURDAY IN MAY, AT THE GOAT BARN ON THE FAIRGROUNDS FROM 10:00 AM TO 12 NOON. THERE WILL BE A \$2.00 CHARGE PER ANIMAL.

ALL MARKET GOATS MUST HAVE MILK TEETH INTACT AT WEIGH-IN.

GOAT USDA IDENTIFICATION PROGRAM

ALL GOATS ENTERED IN THE HARTFORD FAIR FOR THE PURPOSE OF PARTICIPATING IN THE GOAT SHOW AND/OR SALE MUST HAVE OFFICIAL USDA APPROVED SCRAPIES IDENTIFICATION (USDA APPROVED TAGS, USDA APPROVED TATTOOS, OR IDENTIFICATION IN THE SCRAPIE FLOCK CERTIFICATION PROGRAM) INDICATING THE FLOCK OF BIRTH. IDENTIFICATION MUST BE PROVIDED BY OWNER ON RECORD AT TIME OF BIRTH. NO GOAT WILL BE PERMITTED TO SHOW OR SELL DURING THE HARTFORD FAIR WITHOUT SUCH IDENTIFICATION. DOE KIDS ENTERED IN THE MARKET GOAT SHOW, AS WELL AS ALL WETHERS, THAT WERE PURCHASED OUTSIDE OF OHIO, ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A CERTIFICATE OF VETERINARY INSPECTION (CVI) SIGNED BY BOTH THE VETERINARIAN AND THE EXHIBITOR WITHIN 30 DAYS OF THE OPENING OF THE HARTFORD FAIR. (CVI) MUST ATTEST TO THE FOLLOWING: "THE GOATS IN THIS SHIPMENT ARE NOT KNOWN TO BE UNDER ANY MOVEMENT RESTRICTIONS BECAUSE OF SCRAPIE".
