Pee Wee and Old-timers Showmanship Judging – 3:00 pm

- Entries close **Saturday, June 28, 2024, at midnight**
Entry must be made whether a single animal or a group. Entry fee is \$5.00 per lot entered.
- Check health regulations printed in this tabloid. Health papers must be presented before unloading.
- All dairy classes are for registered or grade cattle.
- All exhibits must be in place by **Saturday, August 3 by 2:00 pm.**
• Posted stalling assignments are final. There will be NO changes. Bedding must be straw or pine shavings.
- Wash rack are shut down 6 pm to 9 pm.
- No floor fans are allowed.
- There is to be NO tack stored in the stall space. We reserve the right to remove any tack from stalls not being used to stall animals.
- Each breed must have a minimum of five (5) animals & three (3) families exhibiting or the following year the class will be re-evaluated by the fair board for inclusion.
- A rosette will be given for the Grand Champion, Reserve Champion and Junior Champion in each breed.
- All Junior Fair cows will be shown with the Open Class cows on Thursday. There will be no stalls available for cows. This is a one-day show.
- Barn closes at 11:00 pm every night.

Hartford Fair Cash Premium

All Open Class premiums, except for Goat, Llama, and exhibits located in the Arts/Crafts building will be paid cash premiums at the Hartford Fair Bank. Any premium not picked up by the last day of the fair will be forfeited.
