Event Rules and Guidelines

- One team per 4-H club may enter the contest
- Teams must consist of five members who are each current Hartford Junior Fair exhibitor
- Combined age of team members cannot exceed total of 71
- Event will consist of five Farm Chore challenges, and will be timed.
- Some events are individual in nature, others require multiple team members to complete.
- Teams should report to the green space in front of JFB office 20 minutes prior to the event’s start time.
- The first 20 registrations will be accepted

All teams will compete in preliminary round, with top two teams advancing to final round (in case of tie). Team with the best time will be named the event winner. Winning team will receive a travelling-trophy to display throughout the year. T-shirts will be distributed to participating teams at the conclusion of the contest.
