- 2. Entry must be made, whether a single animal or a group. The entry fee is \$5.00 per lot entered.
- 3. Check the health regulations printed in this tabloid. Health papers must be presented before unloading.
- 4. All dairy classes are for registered or grade cattle.
- 5. All exhibits must be in place by Saturday, August 2<sup>nd</sup>, by 2:00 pm
- 6. The posted stalling assignments are final. There will be no changes. The bedding must be straw or pine shavings.
- 7. The wash rack is shut down from 6 pm to 9 pm
- 8. **NO** floor fans are allowed.
- 9. There is **NO** tack stored in the stall space. We reserve the right to remove any tack from stalls not being used to stall animals.
- 10. Each breed must have a minimum of five (5) animals and three (3) families exhibiting, or the following year, the class will be re-evaluated by the fair board for inclusion.
- 11. A rosette will be given to the Grand Champion, Reserve Grand Champion, Junior Champion, and Reserve Junior Champion in each breed.

- 12. All Junior Fair cows will be shown with the Open Class cows on Thursday. There will be no stalls available for Open cows. This is a one-day show.
- 13. The barn closes at 11:00 pm every night.

- 14. The previous two (2) years' winners of the Dairy Old Timers Showmanship are ineligible.
- 15. The Dairy Herdsman award is based on the following:
  - a. Cleanliness and neatness of the general exhibit area (feed, trunk, aisle, etc.).
  - b. Care of animals (cleaned and well groomed).
  - c. Cooperation with others (Fair officials, other exhibitors, and fair visitors).
  - d. Effort put forth by an individual.
  - e. Previous year's winners are ineligible.
- 16. Only the Champions from each class may compete for the Supreme title.
- 17. Hartford Fair Cash Premium: All Open Class premiums, except for Goats and exhibits located in the Arts/Crafts building, will be paid cash premiums at the Hartford Fair Bank. Any premium not picked up by the fair's last day will be forfeited.
