## JUNIOR FAIR DAIRY SHOWMANSHIP

LOT	DESCRIPTION
1	Junior – Ages 8-11
2	Intermediate – 12-14
3	Senior – 15-18
4	Expert – (Previous Senior/Expert Winner)

1. See Junior Fair rules published at the beginning of the Junior Fair Section of this tabloid.
2. Junior Dairy Judging (calves/heifers) has unlimited entries.
3. All Junior Fair Cows will be shown with the Open Class Cows on Thursday. This is a one (1) day show and there will be no stalls available.
4. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> places in each heifer class that are registered or have reached “qualified status” in alternate or parallel herd books are eligible for Special Premiums.
5. No horns are permitted except on Junior and Intermediate Heifers
6. All entries must be 4-H or FFA projects for the current year.
7. No floor fans are allowed.
8. The barn closes at 11:00 pm every night.

## DAIRY JUDGING CONTEST

The contest will begin promptly at 11:00 am, with instructions and any resource materials being provided at that time. Four **(4)** classes of heifers will be judged. Awards will be given on an individual basis only in two **(2)** divisions – NO Teams.

Junior Division will consist of youth ages 9-13 as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year, and  
The Senior Division will be for those youth ages 14-19 as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year.

All showmanship participants **MUST** sign up in the Fair Entry process when signing up for regular classes.

Dairy Showmanship will be held immediately following the Heifer Show. Exhibitors will be broken into classes as follows: Junior, Intermediate, Senior, and Expert Divisions. Age determined as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Please see the official rules for Expert/Super Showmanship posted at the beginning of the Junior Fair session in the Fair Book.

There will be a Best Fitted Animal award given to the junior exhibitor who does the fitting of their project. The Junior Fair exhibitor must do a fitting. The past two **(2)** years’ winners are ineligible.

The show for Supreme Champion will be immediately after the showing for Breed Classes. The Champion for each dairy cattle breed class is eligible to compete. There will be a Supreme Dairy Champion and a Supreme Junior Dairy Champion.

Junior exhibitors will be eligible to compete for Junior Dairy Herdsman. The past two **(2)** years’ winners are ineligible.

A special premium will be awarded to the winners of each division in the Skill-A-Thon. Divisions are:  
Juniors (ages 9-11 as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year), Intermediates (ages 12-14 as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year), and Seniors (ages 15-18 as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year).

The Junior exhibitor who shows the most tender loving care to his or her livestock project will receive the Kristi J Bruce Memorial Award.
