- 1. Powdering, oiling, or any dressing of hogs other than washing and clean water will not be allowed at the Hartford Fair. Exhibitors will be disqualified from showing if they do not follow this rule. Slick clipping or body shaving means having hair that is less than one-half (1/2) inch in length on the body of market hogs. All hogs must have a minimum of one-half (1/2) inch of hair on their body. ABSOLUTELY NO clipping of hogs will be allowed on the fairgrounds. The whole-body clipping of market hogs is discouraged. The Executive Committee and Swine Committee will interpret all rules not covered in the general rules.
- 2. Following the State guidelines, there will be no health papers required for market hogs, but you will be required to hand in your DUNF at the time you weigh your market hog.
- 3. Bedding must be straw or pine shavings only. **NO** floor fans are allowed.
- 4. **WEIGHTS** Hogs must weigh 200 pounds (**Hogs under 200 pounds will not be sold**) or heavier to compete at the Hartford Fair. Hogs weighing less than 200 pounds will not be allowed to show or sell. Only hogs weighing between 220 290 pounds will be allowed to show in the Champion or Reserve Champion Drive. There will be 30 classes. Classes will be set up equally after the hogs have been weighed.
- 5. All trailers left on the fairgrounds during fair week must be parked in the designated area.
- 6. All market hogs must be identified by an RFID 840 tag, along with breed and color markings have three (3) photos of each hog (ONE (1) OF THE HEAD, ONE (1) OF THE SIDE, AND ONE (1) SHOWING RFID TAG). This

information must be submitted to the Hartford Fair on or before May 15th. You can identify up to four (4) hogs, but only two (2) hogs may be brought to the fair per exhibitor.

- Hogs that do not have 840 RFIDs submitted by May 15<sup>th</sup> will not be eligible to show.
- 8. No swine will be allowed outside the barn.
- The barn will close for loading of the packer truck.
- 10. Hogs must be in the exhibitor's possession by May 1st. There is a maximum entry of two (2) hogs total. Market hogs will be weighed one (1) at a time only. Classes will be divided according to number, weight, and according to sex. The classes will then be separated into four (4) categories (Light, Medium, Light Heavy, and Heavy). Each division's Grand Champion (Gilt & Barrow) will return for the Final Drive, in which a Supreme Champion will be chosen.
- 11. All hogs entered in the Market Hog show are to be shown with the expectation that they will be in the Champion Drive.
- 12. The barn closes at 11:00 pm every night.

## SWINE AGE SHOWMANSHIP AND SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

Swine Age Showmanship is for each exhibitor to compete with only their age for a showmanship title. Juniors will consist of 9-, 10-, and 11-year-olds. Intermediate will consist of 12-, 13-, and 14-year-olds. Seniors will consist of 15-, 16-, 17-, 18-, and 19-

The individual age winners will compete in their division (Junior, Intermediate, Senior, or Expert) in the Swine Showmanship that follows. Please see the official rules for Expert/Super Showmanship posted at the beginning of the Junior Fair section in the Fair Book. All showmanship participants MUST sign up in the Fair Entry process.

#### **OLD TIMERS' SHOWMANSHIP**

Participants are to be over 20 years of age and are required to be a 4-H advisor, 4-H parent, FFA advisor, or former 4-H member in the Hartford Fair District. Judging will be strictly on the showmanship of the individual and not the animals. It is NOT required that anyone own the animal that they exhibit in this class. The class may be divided if necessary. Divisions are Men's and Women's.

# PEEWEE SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

This show is for ages 4-8-year-olds (as of the date of the Peewee show) and will be held on Wednesday at 10:00 am. This show is strictly an educational event. Sign-ups for this event will be held at the hog arena.

The Junior exhibitor who shows the most tender loving care of his or her project will receive the Kristi J. Bruce Award.
