- 1. Exhibits will be displayed in the Poultry/Rabbit Building. Poultry projects do not have to stay on the grounds, but may come on the day of the show.
- 2. Poultry are to be checked and examined by the person in charge before being assigned a pen.
- 3. Pens/cages are available in the barn for exhibits on a first-come, first-served basis.
- 4. All exhibitors must be present when projects are being judged, or judging will not be done, and premiums will be withheld.

5. NO ADULTS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOWRING EXCEPT SHOW OFFICIALS. VIOLATORS MAY BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION!

- 6. Entry limitations of two (2) per lot and six (6) per division
- 7. Poultry must have a negative test for Pullorum/Fowl Typhoid disease within 90 days preceding the opening date of the exhibition and be accompanied by documented evidence that they meet the requirements of this rule.
- 8. All participants **MUST** sign up in the Fair Entry process for showmanship.
- 9. The barn closes at 11:00 pm every night.

Poultry class definitions are as follows:

Market Poultry – Poultry raised for meat purposes only (Commercial)

Broiler - Chicken - Male or Female hatched after May 1st.

Duck & Turkey – Male or Female hatched between March 1st and May 15th.

Egg Type Poultry – Any species or breed of poultry commonly used in commercial egg production, excluding meat production and bantam breeds or varieties.

Cock – Male chicken one (1) year of age or older

Hen – Female chicken one (1) year of age or older

Cockerel – Male chicken up to one (1) year of age

Pullet – Female chicken up to one (1) year of age

Fancy Poultry (Chickens) – Any breed described in the APA Standard of Perfection

Fancy Duck - Any breed described in the APA Standard of Perfection or the ABA Standard of Perfection

Old Drake – Male duck one (1) year of age or older.

Young Drake – Male duck up to one (1) year of age

Old Duck - Female duck one (1) year of age or older

Young Duck – Female duck up to one (1) year of age

Mandatory leg or wing banding on all poultry – Layers and Fancy poultry, and turkeys to be leg banded on the THIRD SATURDAY IN MAY at the fairgrounds BEEF barn from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm

Meat and poultry will be wing banded the SECOND Saturday IN JULY at the fairgrounds BEEF barn from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm.

In case of the death of an animal, replacement may be made with the approval of the Advisor and the Senior Fair Board Poultry Committee member in charge. Replacement must be made with the same breed, sex, and age of the animal lost. There is a \$1.00 charge per entry.

- 3. Registration will begin at 8:00 am on Friday.
- 4. The competition will begin at 8:00 am. The rooster with the most "crows" in a one (1) hour period will be judged as the winner.
- 5. Youth must be present on the day of the contest. If you are not able to be present, you may ask another Junior Fair exhibitor to represent you at the contest.

POULTRY POSTER CONTEST

The poultry poster contest is to demonstrate the Junior Fair exhibitors' project knowledge, to stimulate interest, and to demonstrate to others the diversity of the Junior Fair poultry projects.

- 1. Each poster must be made by a 4-H or FFA member.
- 2. Posters must be made using 22"x28" poster board, displayed horizontally with stiff backing (it is suggested that your poster be covered with clear plastic).
- 3. Each poster must be clearly labeled in the lower right-hand corner, in a space no larger than 3"x5" with the exhibitor's name, club/chapter, and age as of January 1st of the current year.
- 4. Posters will be judged on:
 - a. Educational Content......50 points
 - b. Neatness/Appearance......30 points
- 5. Posters will be displayed at the Poultry/Rabbit Barn during the fair. Poultry posters must be in place by Tuesday at 10:00 am
- 6. Junior Division is 9 13 years of age.
- 7. Senior Division is 14 16.
- 8. No entry fee this is a free class no premiums will be given. Awards for $1st 5^{th}$ places.
