Event Rules and Guidelines

1. One (1) team per 4-H Club/FFA Chapter
2. Teams must consist of five (5) members who are each current Hartford Junior Fair exhibitors.
3. **The combined age of team members cannot exceed a total of 71 years.**
4. The event will consist of five (5) farm chore challenges and will be timed.
5. Some events are individual, and others require multiple team members to complete.
6. Teams should report to the green space in front of the Junior Fair Board Office 20 minutes before the event's start time.
7. The first 20 registrations will be accepted.

All teams will compete in the preliminary round, with the top two (2) teams advancing to the final round (in case of a tie). The team with the best time will be named the event winner. The winning team will receive a traveling trophy to display. out of the year. T-shirts will be distributed to participating teams at the conclusion of the contest.
