Antique Tractor Rules for display:

1. Tractors to be 1976 Model or older.
2. Tractors must be in running condition.
3. Tractors do not have to be newly restored.
4. Regular gate admission is charged.
5. All tractors to be in place by 8:00 pm Saturday, August 2
6. Owners will be responsible for transportation to and from the fairgrounds.
7. The Hartford Independent Agricultural Society will not be responsible for the loss or damage to tractors. For more information contact Dick Fisher.

ANTIQUE TRACTOR PULL

The pull will be on Monday, August 4. Weigh-in will begin at 7:00 a.m., and the pull will begin at 8:00 a.m. The weigh-in will be held in the Centerfield. There will be two (2) classes: Antique Field Stock and Antique Pro Stock.

Weight Classes are: 3500 – 4000 – 4500 – 5000 – 5500 – 6000 – 6500 – 7500 (pounds)

1. Tractors to be 1976 model or older.
2. Tractors must be in running condition.
3. Must be a member of the Land of Legend Antique Tractor Club
4. Regular gate admission is charged.
5. Tractors **MUST** be on display with the Antique Tractors to participate.
6. The Hartford Independent Agricultural Society will not be responsible for the loss or damage to tractors.

DEPT. 31 – PEDAL TRACTOR PULLS

The Hartford Fair pull will be held on Sunday, August 3, at Grubb Arena. Registration will be from 2:00 pm – 3:00 pm with pull beginning at 3:00 pm. Classes for ages 4 – 11 years.

1. The contestant must be able to pedal the tractor without help.
2. Pedal tractors will be furnished for all participants.
3. All contestants must wear shoes.
4. The pulling tractor must always stay between the lines of the pulling track.
5. If the tractor leaves the pulling lane, the distance will be measured from the starting line to the point where the tractor crosses the boundary.
6. The child may not place their hand on the tractor tire at any time during the pull to help increase their pulling distance.
7. The child may not place one or both feet on the ground to push the tractor forward.
8. There can be no loss of forward pressure. In other words, they cannot hesitate or never jerk the equipment.
9. The child will remain in the seat at all times. If a contestant lifts off the seat, the pull will be stopped, and their distance will be measured to that point.
10. The judge's decision will be final for all pulls.
11. All contestants must be present at the time of the pedal pull with the assigned permission slip in hand. The required signature of a parent or guardian that releases all parties involved from any financial responsibility due to the accident.
12. The child must be accompanied by an adult or guardian at the time of registration.
13. Spectators must stay in the stands.
14. Arguing with the track officials by a contestant, parent, or guardian will not be allowed and could result in disqualification of the contestant. Everyone will display sportsmanship in all cases, and should that not be possible, the offender will be asked to leave. No one is perfect, but we will handle things in the proper way.
15. All rulings by track officials are final and may supersede any of the above rules. If a sled must be re-weighed, the group pulling at that time may start over.
16. Sanctioning: In OHIO, the sanctioned pull will qualify the top three (3) participants in each age division, 4-11. They will qualify for the Buckeye State-sanctioned Kiddy Pedal Pull Championship held on Saturday, August 9, in the Swine Complex.
