Articles must be picked up on Sunday, August 10th from 11:00 am to 2:00 pm. **NO SATURDAY PICKUPS!** Perishable items will be disposed of at the discretion of the committee. The Hartford Fair is not responsible for items left in the building after August 10th. Unclaimed items will only be kept for 30 days after the fair.

No purchased articles can compete for a premium. Any article entered out of its class will be disqualified. Soiled articles will not be considered by the judges. Each exhibitor may enter as many class categories as they desires. But only one (1) entry to each category (or lot number) with the exception of the "Baby Quilt Contest, Crochet/Knitting Contest for Babies, and the Patriotic Quilt. RAISIN PIE RECIPE FOR LOT #4

2 Cups Raisins ¹/₄ Teaspoon Salt

2 Cups Water 2 Tablespoons Lemon Juice ½ Cup Sugar Pastry for 9" Double Crust Pie

3 Tablespoons Flour

Preheat Oven to 425

Combine raisins and water in a heavy-bottomed saucepan, cook over medium heat, stirring often, until mixture boils. Remove from heat. Stir the sugar, flour, and salt together and add to the raisin mixture, blending well. Return to the heat and cook, stirring often, until the mixture boils. Let boil for 2 minutes. Remove from heat and add lemon juice. Spoon mixture into pie shell and spread evenly. Cover with top crust, trim and crimp edges, then cut vents for steam to escape. Bake for about 35 minutes or until the crust is nicely browned.

LEMON BARS RECIPE FOR LOT #11

1 Cup Butter, softened ½ Cup White Sugar

2 Cups All Purpose Flour

4 Eggs

1 1/2 Cups White Sugar

4 Tablespoons All Purpose Flour

2 Lemons, juiced

Confectioner's Sugar for dusting

Preheat Oven to 350

In a medium bowl, blend softened butter, 2 cups of flour, and $\frac{1}{2}$ cup sugar. Press into the bottom of an ungreased 9x13-inch pan.

Bake for 15-20 minutes in a preheated oven, or until firm and golden. In another bowl, whisk together the remaining 1½ cups of sugar and 4 tablespoons of flour. Whisk in the eggs and lemon juice. Pour over the baked crust.

Bake for an additional 20 minutes in the preheated oven. The bars will firm up as they cool. After the pan has cooled, dust with confectioner's sugar and cut into uniform bars.

2 Cups All-Purpose Flour 1 Cup Mayonnaise 1 Pinch of Salt 1 Cup Warm Water 2 Teaspoons Baking Soda 1 Teaspoon Vanilla
