- 1. Entries close Friday, June 27th, at midnight
- 2. Entry must be made whether a single animal or a group. The entrance fee is \$5 per lot entered.
- 3. Check the health regulations printed in this tabloid. Health papers must be presented before unloading.
- 4. Open Class Beef Only exhibitors have the option of arriving on the day of the show and are excused to leave at the conclusion of the show. Barn space will not be provided for Open Class only cattle.
- 5. Bedding must be straw or pine shavings. All exhibitors must clean up their own bedding before leaving the fairgrounds or forfeit premiums and no entry the following year.
- 6. **NO** floor fans are allowed.
- 7. Each breed must have a minimum of five (5) animals and three (3) families exhibiting, or the following year the class will be re-evaluated by the fair board for inclusion.
- 8. All cattle, regardless of age, showing under breed or all other breed classification must be registered/recorded and appear in the name of the exhibitor or immediate family member, or family farm on the records of the respective association. All unregistered animals must be entered and shown as crossbreeds. Simmentals must be ½ or higher.
- 9. All breed exhibitors must enter their registration number during online entry. All Breed Open Class exhibitors must present registration documents and animals to the Registered Beef Check-in location between 2:30 and 3:30 pm on the day of the show. Animals must correspond to the description, tattoo, and ownership as shown by registration and transfer certificates. Failure to comply forfeits all rights to show and/or awards.
- 10. Exhibitor number cards must be displayed on the back of exhibitors in the show ring.
- 11. Champion Heifers from each class will come back to compete for Supreme and Supreme Reserve Champion
- 12. The barn closes at 11:00 pm every night.

OPEN FEEDER CALF

NO PRE-ENTRY

Enter your feeder calf day of the show. Monday, August 4th

Entry/Weigh in: 1:30-2:30 pm – show at 4:00 pm

- 1. Open show for heifers and steers born January 1 or after in the current year.
- 2. Enter the day of the show. The entry fee is \$20 per calf and is due day of weigh-in
- 3. All steer calves must be castrated before June 1. Any steers with testicular tissue will be ineligible to show.
- 4. Cattle must be dehorned to be eligible.
- 5. May exhibit up to four (4) animals.
- 6. Feeder calf's minimum weight is 300 pounds, and maximum weight of 700 pounds.
- 7. Stalls in the Beef Barn are allowed only if the exhibitor has other beef projects and barn space is available.
- 8. Calves will be shown by weight, no breed classes no more than 10 calves per class.
- 9. The top five (5) overall will be paid as follows: 1st-\$150; 2nd-\$100; 3rd-\$75; 4th-\$50; 5th-\$25 or 70% of entry fee (whichever is greater).
- 10. Hartford Fair Cash Premium: All Open Class premiums, except for Goats and exhibits located in the Arts/Crafts building, will be paid cash premiums at the Hartford Fair Bank. Any premium not picked up by the fair's last day will be forfeited.
